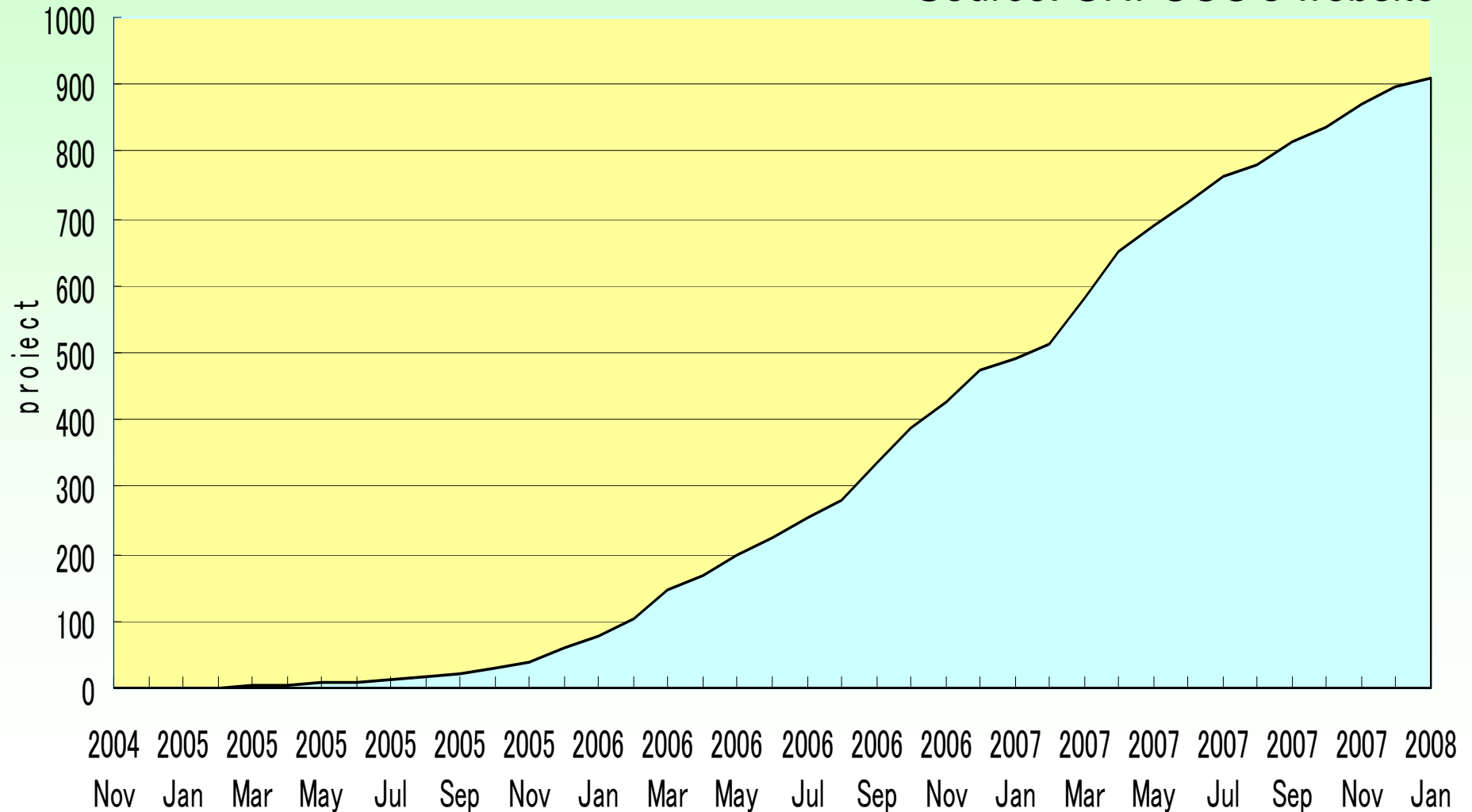


The number of world registered CDM projects

- Registration of 945 CDM project activities (as of 20 Feb)
- Issuance of 1,170,000,000 million certified emission reductions. (as of 20 Feb)
- The number of registered projects have been increased since 2006.

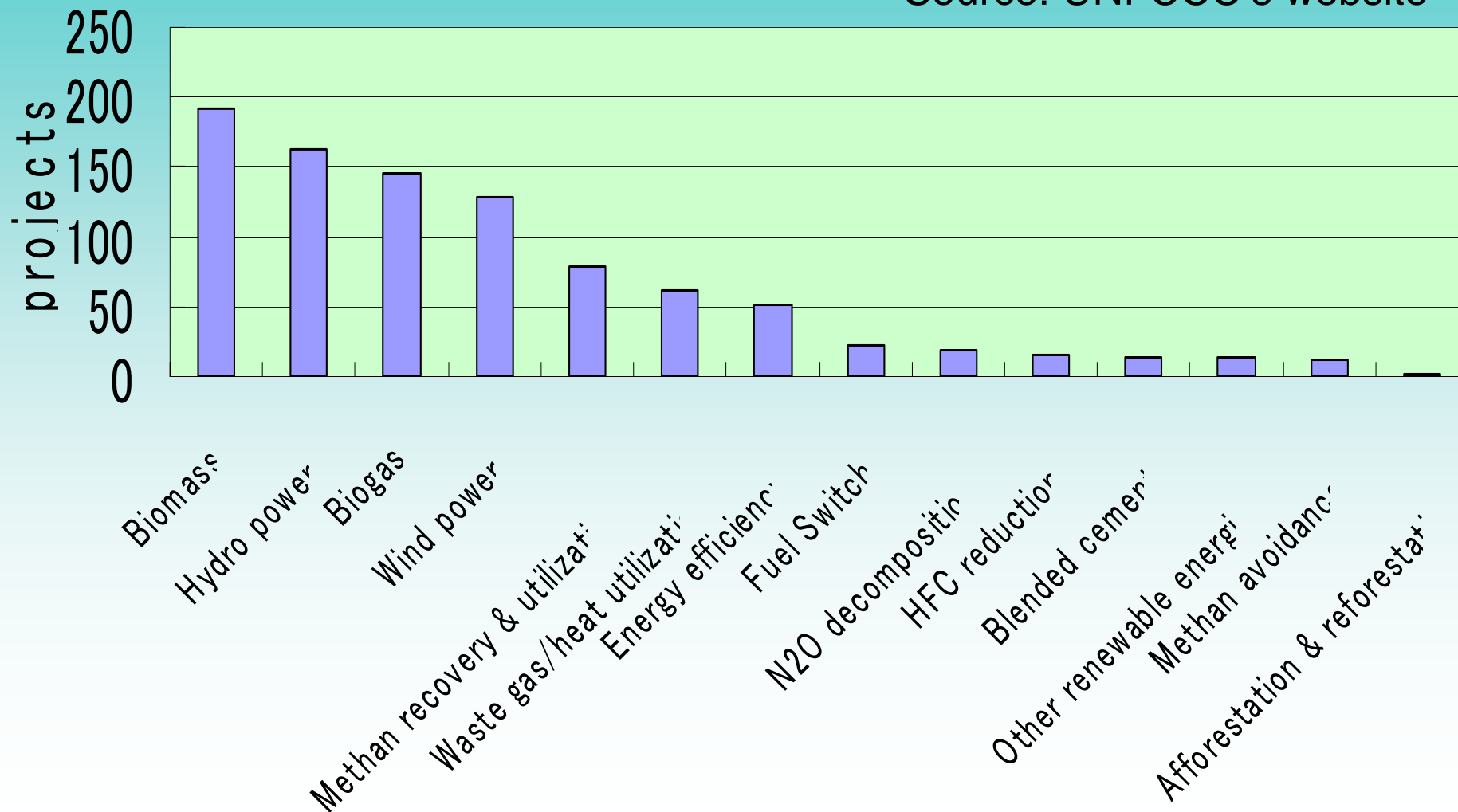
Number of UN registered projects by month between Nov 2004 and Jan 2008

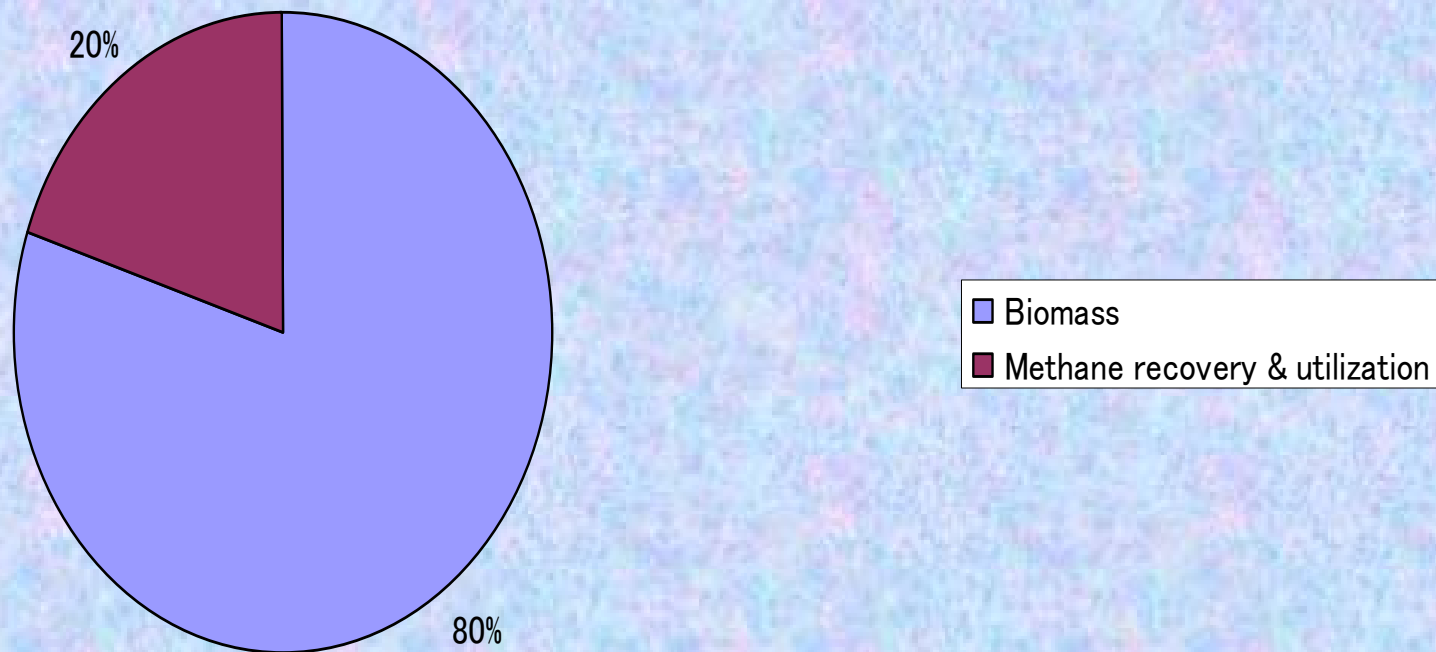




The tendency of current CDM types

- Biomass, Hydro Power, Biogas are the top 3 projects.
- A few N₂O composition and HFC reduction projects are registered
- A few afforestation and reforestation projects are registered.

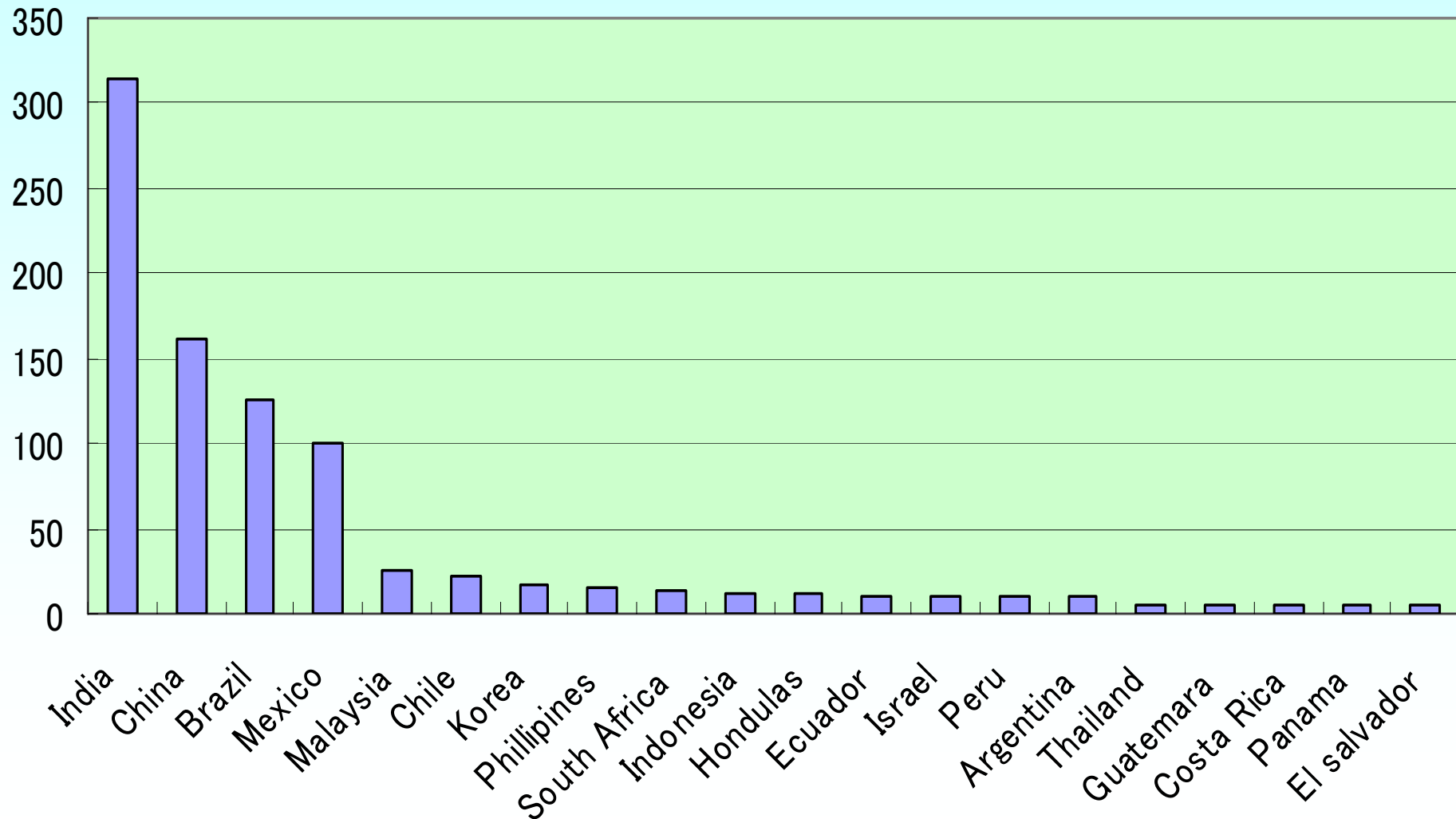

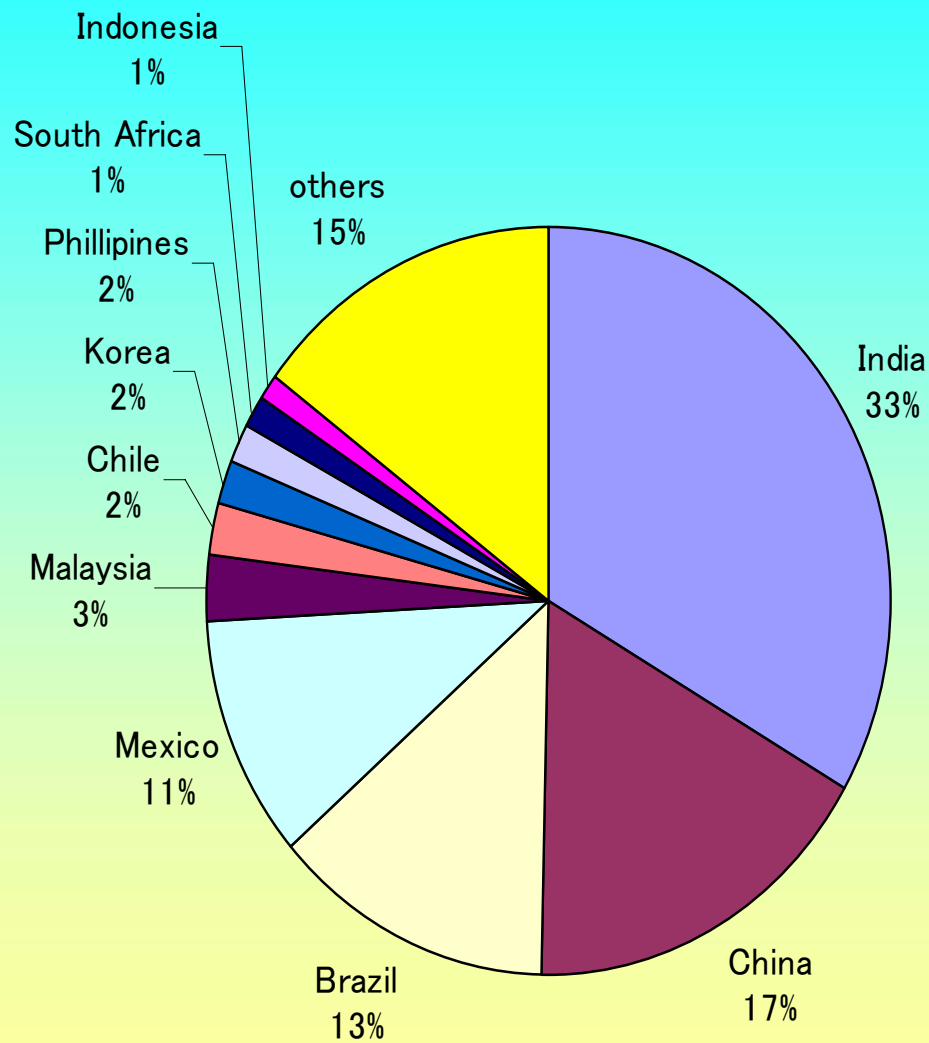

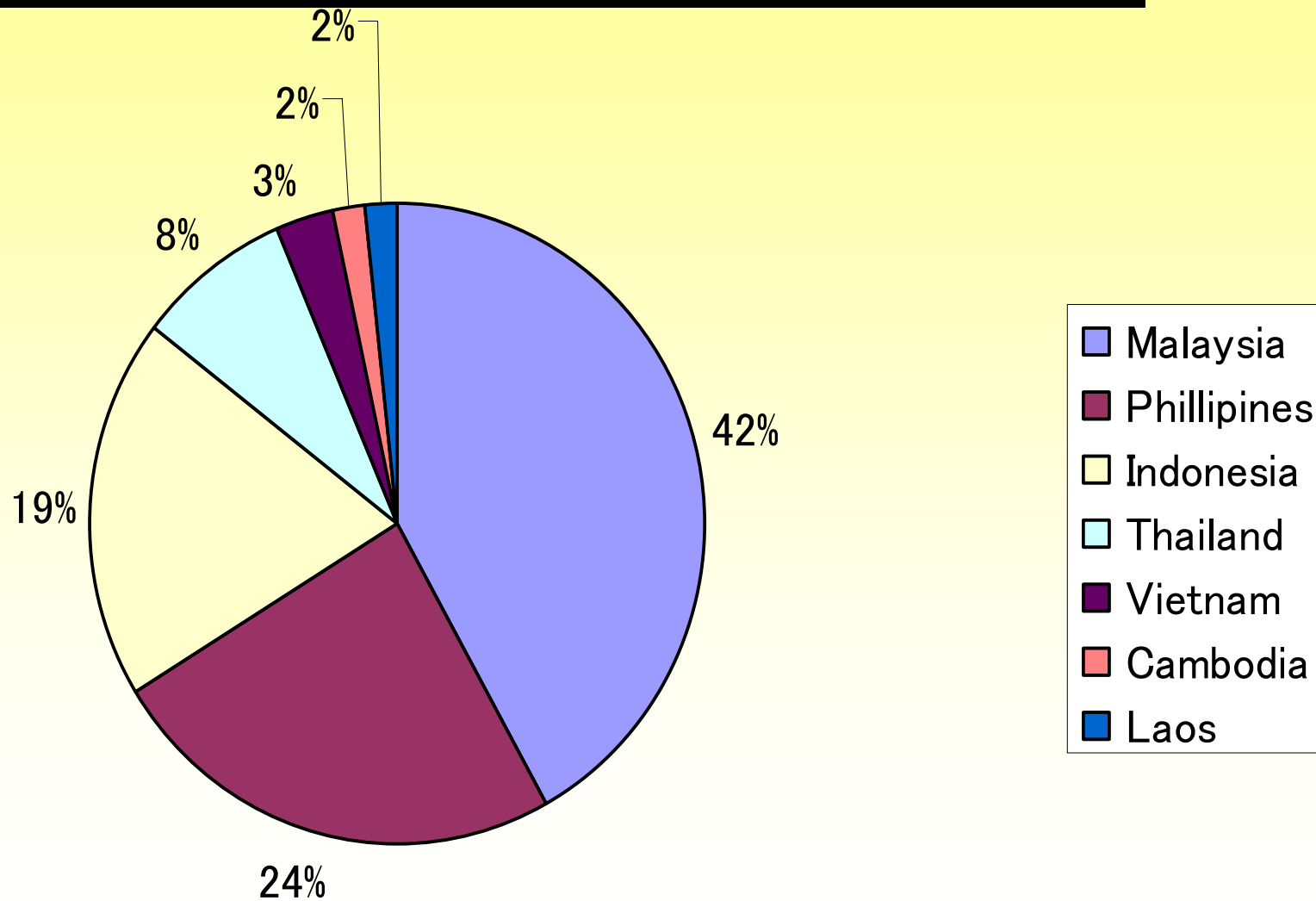


registered projects by the country

The reason why Thai registered numbers are small at this moment

- Due to the domestic political difficulties, the Thai government had some delays in the approval.
- TGO was established on 6 July 2007, have issued a lot of LoAs in the short period.
- The number of Thai governmental approval projects have been increasing since 2007.



Conclusion

- The number of world UN registered CDM have been increasing from 2006.
- The number of registered projects in Thailand is small due to the political confusion in 2006.
- TGO has just established but now Thai governmental approval procedure gain the momentum, expected to increase Thai UN registered projects.
