## TBCSD Manifesto for Energy Efficiency in Buildings

Approximately 40% of the world's energy is used in buildings - more than in transport or industry. Since energy used in buildings is the major contribution to climate change, it must be addressed.

Thai business and government sectors must act as social leaders to show their awareness of the significance of lower energy use in buildings.

Leadership in energy efficiency in buildings represents opportunities to cut operating costs, improve employee productivity and satisfaction, and enhance corporate reputation.

Thai business and government sectors can set new standards of energy efficiency for their commercial buildings that will increase worldwide demand for energy efficient buildings.

Our collective efforts can result in significant reductions in worldwide energy use and corresponding carbon emissions.

This manifesto, which aims to mobilize TBCSD members and business sectors to improve the energy performance of their commercial buildings, has five actions.

1. To create a baseline of the organization's buildings and set CO<sub>2</sub> reduction targets in line with transformative change.
2. To publish an organization policy for minimum energy performance levels in the organization's commercial buildings.
3. To define and carry out the organization's audit program and implementation strategy to meet energy targets for its commercial buildings.
4. To publish annually buildings' energy use, CO<sub>2</sub> emissions and progress for reduction targets, in the annual or CSR report.
5. To further promote building energy efficiency among stakeholders/alliances
