

SUCCESS project – Criteria and conditions for VA studies (Activity 1.3)

- SUCCESS project will provide funding for VA studies
- Budget is 5,000 Euro per study (amount in Thai Baht will depend on the exchange rate)
- Budget is allocated for 5,000 Euro x 10 studies for both Northeast and South (or 25,000 Euro per region)
- TEI will sign sub-agreements with SCF / CSNM based on approved proposals
- Only CSOs participated in Activities 1.1 and 1.2 can apply



SUCCESS project – Criteria and conditions for VA studies (Activity 1.3)

- Each VA study must involve i) at least 1 community, ii) different community groups (e.g. women, low-income households, urban poor, disabled, elderly, marginalised), iii) at least 1 municipality
- Duration of the VA implementation 8-10 months (no longer than 10 months)



Plans for vulnerability assessment studies (Activity 1.3)

- Step 1. Developing proposals and planning of vulnerability assessment activities
- Step 2. Reviewing and finalising proposals for funding
- Step 3. Preparing and signing sub-agreements (TEI-SCF)
- Step 4. Implementation (8-10 months)
- Step 5. Monitoring and evaluation
- Step 6. Learning and reflection (Activity 1.4)



Step 1. Developing proposals and VA plans

- Nov-Dec 2020 (Project Year 2)
- CSOs decide how they want to work e.g. agree on number of groups, identify members of each group
- Each group will work with SCF / CSNM to
 - i. Identify location / number of communities / municipality
 - ii. Design data collection activities
 - iii. Develop work plans and timelines



Step 2. Review and finalise proposals and VA plans

- Nov2020-Jan 2021
- TEI working with SCF / CSNM to refine proposals and VA plans
- TEI working with SCF / CSNM to agree on timelines, work plans and M&E



Step 3. Sub-agreements

- February 2021
- Finalise and sign sub-agreements (TEI-SCF/CSNM)



Step 4. Implementation (8-10 months)

- March 2021 starting date
- Progress report 5 months after starting date
- Final report 10 months after starting date
- Financial reports at Month 5 and Month 10
- (1 March 31 December 2021 = 10 months)
- (Final report submission 31 December 2021)



Step 5. M&E plans

- TEI will work with SCF / CSNM to develop M&E plans
- M&E Month 5 and Month 10



Step 6. Learning and reflection (Activity 1.4)

- Project Year 3
- SLD approach bringing CSO groups together with local multi-stakeholders
- Date to be determined (early 2022)
