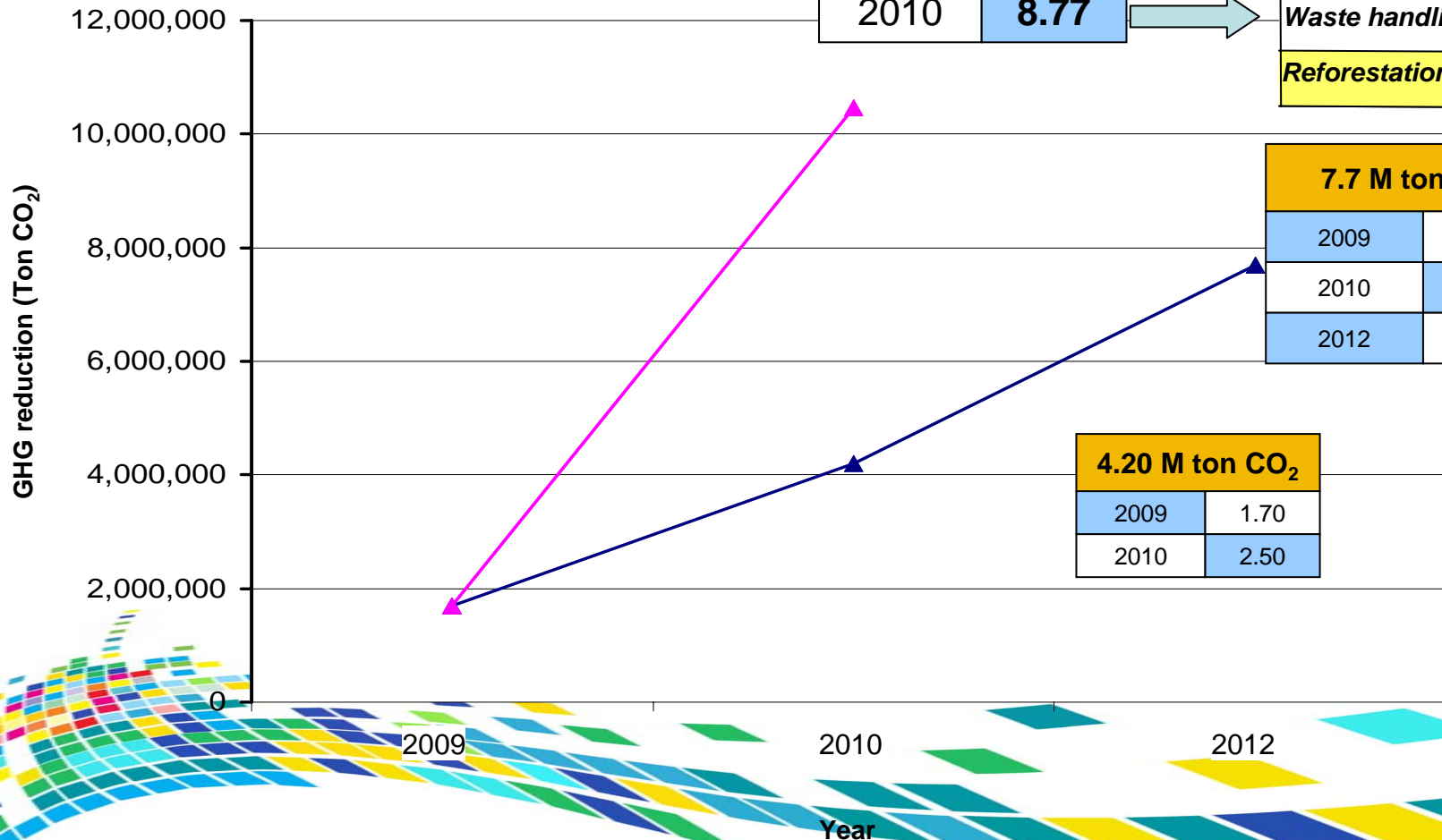

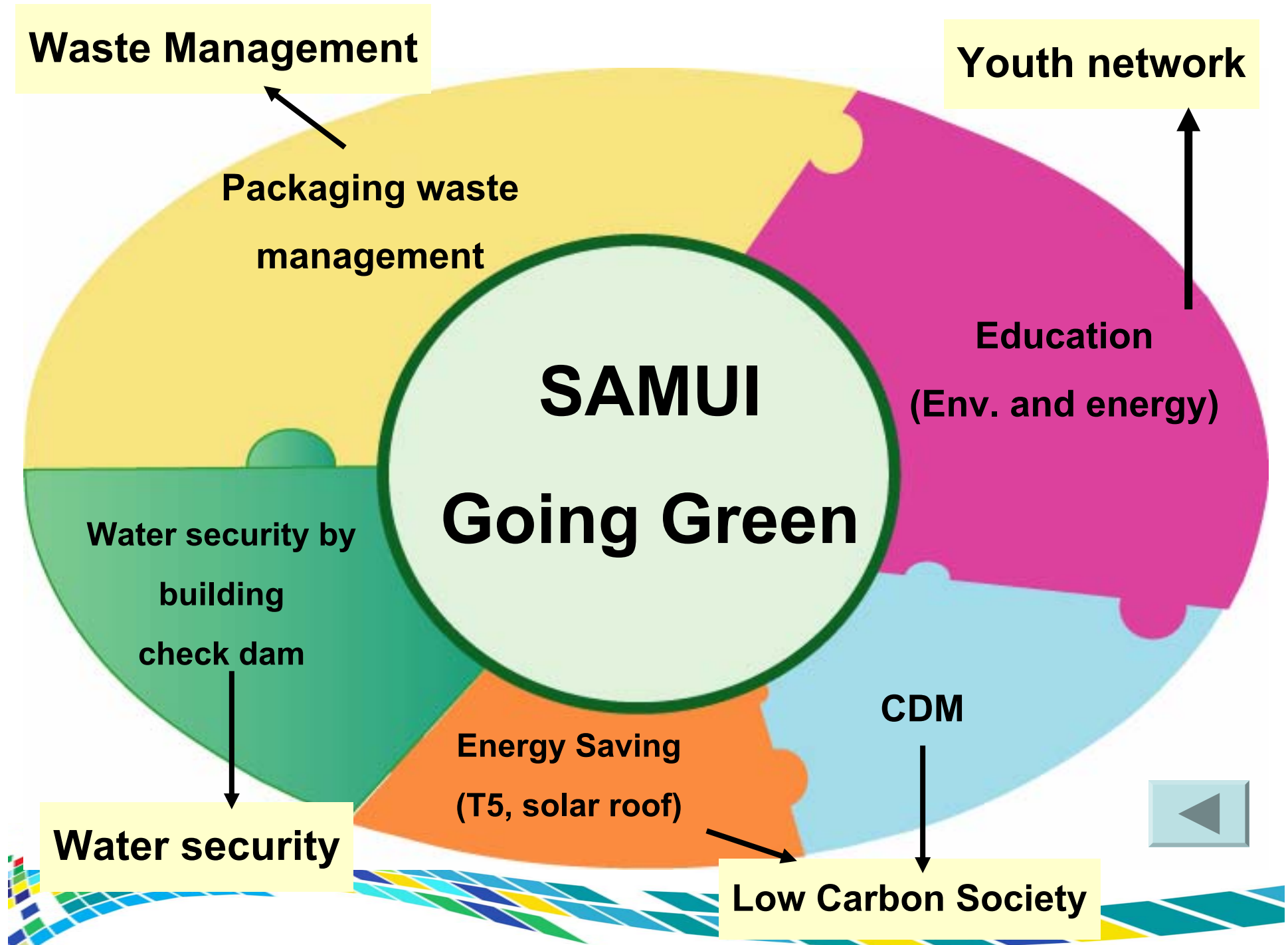

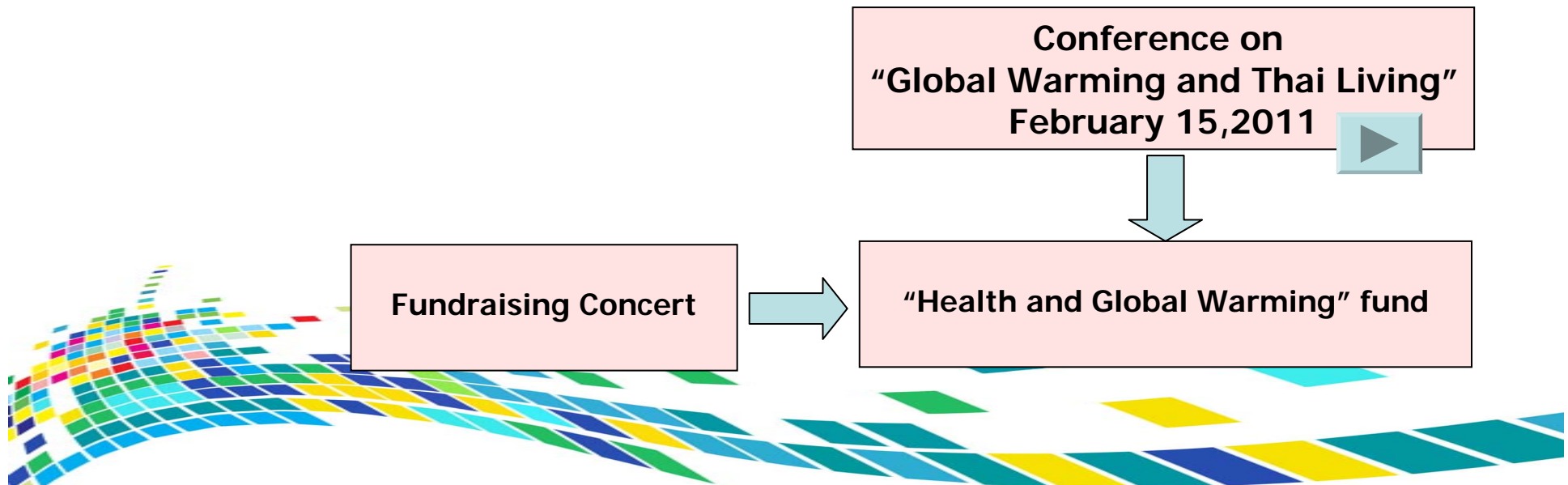

# Eco School Award by TBCSD 3<sup>rd</sup> Season

## Objective:

Eco School Award by TBCSD 3<sup>rd</sup> season is then an extension program to other schools which emphasize capacity development of the school and students in systematic environmental management and to encourage the school to develop more curriculum development concerning environment.

**Budget:** 500,000 THB



# Eco Friend Award

## Objectives:

TBCSD thus presents Eco-Friend Award for teachers who develop a curriculum supporting students to learn and increase awareness of energy and environment conservation. This award helps create a role model of teacher for energy and environment studies which extends the effect and ensures sustainability.

## Scope:

- Criteria development and establishment of committee for preliminary selection.
- Selection of teachers to receive Eco-Friend Award in 2 levels; primary and secondary school

**Budget:** 500,000 THB



# Eco Hospital Award

## Objective:

To support and encourage hospitals which in part cause pollution and which work closely to communities to manage their own facilities and operation to be environmental friendly.
