### 1. Green SIEP: The Sirindhorn International Environmental Park

In 2014, the area behind the energy center in the Sirindhorn international environmental park will be renovated to provide open space about 13 rai which divided into 3 areas:

Phase 1 area, 3.73 rai, 750 tree

Phase 2 area, 3.52 rai, 750 tree

Phase 3 area, 5.37 rai, 1000 tree

Budget: 100,000 baht

- 1. Baan Huai Pu Ling, Mea Hong Son (Hydro power), 35 kw (PTT)
- 2. Baan Hua Ha, Mea Hong Son (Solar cells), 3.0 kw (RATCH)
- 3. Baan Pa Yoi, Mea Hong Son (Hydro power), 35 kw (EGAT)

- 1. Explore the possibility of establishing community power plants
- 2. Assess the operation
- 3. Develop and design power plants
- 4. Raise funds for the project
- 5. Execute operations
